



Metric Goody Bag

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Paper Size:

- One 11 cm x 29 cm piece of cardstock or patterned paper
- One 11 cm x 8 cm piece of coordinating cardstock or patterned paper

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal
- Circle cutting system or punch for peek a boo window
- Border punch or decorative cutting blade
- Crop A Dile or hand held circle punch
- Clear bag – maximum width of 11 cm, height approx 15 cm – 16 cm
- Ribbon
- Stamps and ink

Step 1

Align the 11 cm x 29 cm piece of patterned paper to the top fence, left side, and score at 12 cm and 17 cm.



Step 2

Align the 11 cm x 8 cm piece of cardstock, with the 8cm side at the top fence, left side, and score at 4cm.



Step 3 and 4

Cut a circle into the front of the bag using a circle cutting system. For this sample a Nestabilities circle die was used. Circle was cut a bit lower on the front panel to compensate for the bag topper. Create a decorative edge on both sides of the bag topper. After cutting, prefold all scores and set scores with the Scor-Tool™.



Step 5

To complete Goody Bag, fill a cello bag with a bit of crinkle and your favorite treats, fold top over slightly and adhere a piece of transparent tape to keep it closed. Insert filled cello into bag cover and add bag topper. Holding all these in place, punch 2 holes through all layers with a Crop A Dile or similar hole punch. Thread ribbon through all holes and tie a bow. Embellish as desired.
