
Coffin Treat Box Tutorial

Supplies

Card stock, for coffin, 5 1/4" x 3 3/4" Card stock for coffin lid, 3" x 4 1/4" Template for lid Scor-Pal® Scor-Tape (1/2") Embellishments



<u>Step 1:</u> Score larger piece of cardstock at $\frac{1}{2}$ " on all four sides.

<u>Step 2:</u> Position paper at the one inch groove, score at the 2 1/8" groove.



Step 4:

Snip wedges in score marks separating the box sides from the end flaps. Cut either side of score line, bringing the cut to a point.





Step 3: Snip off the three outer squares at corner.



<u>Step 5:</u> Place Scor-Tape as shown in photo.



Step 6:

Assemble box bottom folding score lines so the indented score lines are on the outside of the folds. Tuck the end folds in last.

Step 7:

Print out coffin lid template on paper. This is found on the web site. Cut on the outside of the black lines. Lay the template on your remaining cardstock and cut out. If you are using any cardstock other than black you could probably print the template right on the sheet of cardstock. Embellish.

Score edge tab of lid. Glue to the side of the box. Voilá a Coffin Treat Box.
