

Metric Pizza Boxes

These make great little gift boxes. Perfect for one large cookie or other treats!

Paper Size:

• One – 16 cm x 29 cm

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Tape[™] or double sided adhesive
- Scor-Mat[™] (metric coming soon)
- Craft knife
- Metal edged ruler
- Scissors
- Circle punch
- Ribbon
- If desired, stamped and matted images for top of box (not shown in sample)

Step 1

Align the 16 cm side of paper to top fence, left side, and score at 3 cm and 13 cm. You are always scoring on the right side of the paper., the side you want to be on the outside of the box.



<u>Step 2</u>
Rotate ¼ turn and align 29 cm side to top fence, left side, and score at 3 cm, 13 cm, 16 cm, and 26 cm.



<u>Step 3 and 4</u> Step 3: Cut 8 scores, 4 per side, along the long sides to where the score lines intersect. You'll be cutting on the 3 cm, 13 cm, 16 cm and 26 cm scored lines, 4 cuts on each long side. Step 4: Notch flaps then punch ½ circle at the midpoint on one end.





Adhere Scor-Tape™ to notched flaps.

Step 6

Pre-fold all scores.



<u>Step 7</u> Adhere flaps to create box.



<u>Step 8</u>
Decorate as desired or simply tie a beautiful ribbon around box.



Metric Mini Pizza Box

Paper Size:

• 1 – 14 cm x 25 cm

Align 14 cm side at the top fence, left side, and score at 3 cm and 11 cm.

 $\underline{\textbf{Step 2}}$ Rotate $\frac{1}{2}$ turn and with the 25 cm side at the top fence, left side, and score at 3 cm, 11 cm, 14

To assemble mini box follow directions for the original metric pizza box.
