

# Kleenex Box

## Instructions

- Cut cardstock to 20 cm x 20 cm.
- Score vertically at 3 cm, 9 cm, 12 cm, and 18 cm.
- Score horizontally at 5 cm and 17 cm.
- Additionally, score horizontally at 2 cm, as shown on diagram.
- Cut the vertical score lines as shown.
- Cut and remove portions as indicated on diagram.
- Using Oval Nestabilities die, cut oval shape as shown.
- Attach 1/4 inch wide Scor-Tape to inside surface as shown on diagram below.
- Fold on scored lines. With Scor-Pal bone folder, press the folds to reinforce.
- Assemble box in 3 sections, starting with the center section. Peel off backing from Scor-Tape. Fold box and seal closed, hiding Side Tab.
- Bottom section: Peel off backing from Scor-Tape. Fold Bottom Flaps in, starting with Flap 1, then Flap 3, then Flap 2. Folding Flap 4 in will seal the bottom closed.
- Insert small package of Kleenex, first removing plastic covering on the Kleenex.
- Top section: Fold Top Flap in and seal closed.
- Cut length of ribbon. Tie ribbon in a bow. Adhere to box front using Scor-Tape. Alternately, you may thread ribbon through punched holes and tie in a bow.
- Using Oval and Scalloped Oval Nestabilities dies, cut oval shapes as shown and adhere to box front using Scor-Tape..
- Decorate as desired with paper flowers and stickers of choice.
