

# Bathroom Tile Card

## Supplies:

Scor-Pal  
Stamps: My Favorite Things  
Cardstock: white, black, blue white, silver  
Ink: Black Noir, white pigment, versamark  
Color pencils  
Glitter glue  
Pop dots  
Ribbon  
Decorative flower punches  
Clear embossing powder

### Step 1:

Stamp tub image onto white cardstock. Stamp mirror portion again onto silver cardstock. Cut out center of silver mirror, and attach to center of mirror on the white cardstock.

### Step 2:

Color the images as desired.

### Step 3:

Stamp front panel of blue folded card with white pigment ink.

### Step 4:

Place a black panel onto the Scor-Pal and line up to the left and top fences. Score at every half inch 1/2", Next, line up left edge with the 1/4" mark. Score at every half inch. Turn card 90 degrees and repeat. You now have a 1/4" grid.

### Step 5:

Apply versamark ink over entire card and emboss with clear powder. Repeat until

your card is uniformly covered. You have now made  $\frac{1}{4}$ " bathroom tiles.

**Step 6:**

Stamp word onto ribbon with black ink. Wrap around the bottom of a  $3\frac{1}{2}$  x 5" tiled panel. Adhere all to the front of the blue folded card.

**Step 7:**

Cut out the background wall from the stamped and colored image, and discard. Cut out  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of tiled background and adhere onto image to create new "tiled" bathroom wall.

**Step 8:**

Adhere all onto silver panel, and adhere to black tiled panel with pop dots.

**Step 9:**

Apply glitter glue to the bathtub and lower right side of image to create bubbles.

**Step 10:**

Punch out coordinating flowers and layer together to create one flower. Glue onto ribbon. Apply rhinestone sticker to center of flower.
