

5" Square Envelosatchel

This project was inspired by the card caddy satchel by Lynn Smith - posted in the April/May 2008 projects

The completed envelosatchel measures 5 3/8" x 5 3/8" with a depth of just over 1/2" – lots of room for heavily embellished card.

Step 1: Cut double sided heavy card stock to 9" square. Score on RIGHT side of paper

Step 2: Align top point with 7" position on Scor-Pal and bottom point with 7" line on Scor-Mat. Score at the inverted triangle & 4 1/4". Repeat with three remaining corners.

Step 3: Notch out where the lines intersect.

Step 4: Fold on both lines on each corner and crease with scor tool. Apply adhesive to inside edges of bottom flap where they will intersect with side flaps. Top flap can be fastened with adhesive or by applying velcro dot or magnet to inside of top flap and corresponding place on bottom of envelosatchel.

Step 5: Decorate/embellish as desired.
