

Flap Card

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Supplies:

Scor-Pal®

Scor-Tape™

3½" x 11" piece of card stock

3¼" x 4" piece of coordinating patterned paper

3¼" x 4" piece of neutral cardstock (for inside)

Rubber stamps, (Stampin' Up!) ink, and coordinating card stock for stamping and matting image

Coluzzle® Cutting system with circle template

Paper cutter

BasicGrey magnetic snap closures (or similar product)

Punches, ribbon and/or embellishments you desire

SU Dimensionals/Pop up dots

Step 1:

Use 3½" x 11" piece of card stock, your Coluzzle® with the circle template, to trim the top edge using the most outer channel of template.

Step 2: Trim the straight edge of your card stock to measure a total length of 10 3/8". (Re-check your measurements using the start of the curve to the straight edge. The length should be 9 1/2 ". Make necessary adjustments.)

Step 3: Score card stock at 4 1/4" and 8 1/2".

Step 4: Fold at scores, and adhere patterned paper to lower flap. (This is also when I pierced the top flap edge).

Step 5: Stamp, color, and mat your image, then adhere to top flap using Stampin' Up! Dimensionals or similar product.

Step 6: Use magnetic closures on the back of main image, and base of the card.

Step 7: Adhere neutral card stock to base to cover exposed magnet.

Step 8: Finish project using any coordinating ribbon and/or embellishments you desire.
