



Metric Easel Card

Paper Sizes:

- One 10 cm x 10 cm piece of cardstock
- One 10 cm x 20 cm piece of cardstock
- Two 10 cm x 10 cm pieces of coordinating patterned paper

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal™
- Button or similar embellishment for easel stop
- Other: dies, stamps and ink, card embellishments

Step 1

Align the 20 cm side of cardstock to the top fence, left side, and score at 5 cm and 10 cm.



Step 2

Pre-fold and set scores with the Scor-Tool.



Step 3 and 4

Place Scor-Tape on flap, as shown. Adhere a button to the center of one of the 10 cm x 10 cm pieces of patterned paper. For this sample, the button is sewn to the patterned paper before adhering to the cardstock base. You may also use a glue dot or similar adhesive.



Step 5

Adhere patterned paper to the 10 cm x 10 cm piece of cardstock. Decorate as desired with stamps, ink and embellishments. Remove Scor-Tape from base card and adhere finished panel. Rest image panel behind button to enjoy your Easel Card!



Finished project is 10 cm x 10 cm when collapsed. Easel cards may be made in any size as long as the base is twice the length of the image panel.

14 cm x 14 cm square card	14 cm x 28 cm, 12 cm x 12 cm	7 cm and 14 cm
10 cm x 14 cm card	10 cm x 28 cm, 10 cm x 14 cm	7 cm and 14 cm
