



Metric Photo Wallet

Paper Sizes

- One - 11 cm x 27.5 cm piece of double sided patterned paper
- One - 4.5 cm x 19 cm piece of double sided patterned paper
sample uses opposite side of wallet paper
- Three - 6.5 cm x 20 cm pieces of coordinating cardstock
sample uses 2 different colors; 2 each of red, 1 of yellow
- Three - 6 cm x 9.5 cm pieces of coordinating cardstock
sample uses 2 different colors; 2 each of yellow, 1 of red
- Three - 3 cm x 10 cm strips of patterned paper

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Tape™
- Corner Rounder
- Distressing tool
- Stamps and ink
- Scallop and Circle punches
- Adhesive

Step 1



Align the 27.5 cm side at the top fence, left side, and score at 12 cm and 20 cm.

Step 2

Move paper to the 5mm mark and score at 4 cm. Note position of left side of paper



Step 3

Align each 6.5 cm x 20 cm piece of coordinating cardstock at the top fence, left side, and score at 10 cm. Score each piece independently, photo is for visual purposes. These will become the photo covers.



Step 4

Round the corners of the wallet base and the 3 photo covers.



Step 5

Pre-fold all scores on wallet base and photo covers.



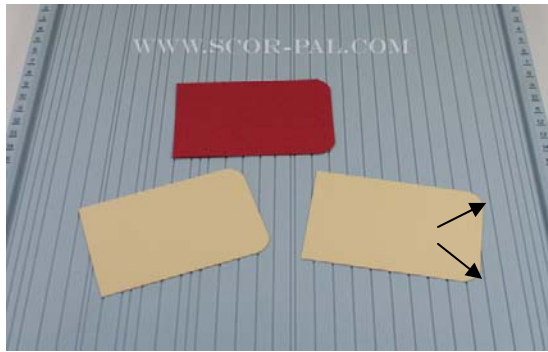
Step 6

Adhere photo covers to inside wallet, alternate openings, as shown. Adhere patterned paper strips to covers.



Step 7

Round the two corners, as shown, on the 6 cm x 9.5 cm pieces of coordinating cardstock.



These will become the photo mats.

Step 8

Glue photo mats to photo covers.

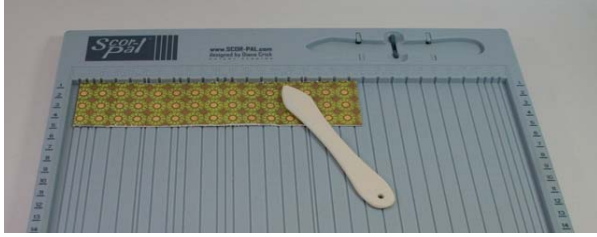


Step 9

Align the 4.5 cm x 19 cm piece of patterned paper at the top fence, left side, and score at 5 cm. Edges have been distressed with a distressing tool before scoring. This will become the belt for the wallet.



Move to the 5 mm mark and score at 14 cm



Step 10

Prefold scores and place a small piece of Scor-Tape on one end.



Step 11

Decorate front of photo wallet as desired with stamps, ink, punches, etc.
Add your favorite photos as a fun gift to remember a special moment or event. Journaling panels may be added to the inside of the photo covers.
