

“Monogram Place Card”

Supplies:

Scor-Pal®
Scor-Tape™
Cardstock
Designer Paper
Scalloped Circle Punch
1 3/8" Circle Punch
1 1/4" Circle Punch
SU Word Window Punch
Dies-cut Alphabet Set
Sakura Quickie Glue Pen
Sakura Clear Glitter Pen
Ink and Sentiment Stamp
Paper Piercing Tool



Step 1:

Cut base cardstock to 2 1/4" x 3 1/4".
Cut next layer 2" x 3".
Cut Designer paper to 1 3/4" x 2 3/4".
Glue these together the smallest being on top.

Step 2:

Punch out the 1 1/4" circle.
Punch out the 1 3/8" circle.
Punch out the scalloped circle.
Glue these together the smallest being on top.
Glue on your monogram letter.

Step 3:

Pierce outer scallop. Make faux eyelets using the Glitter Pen.



Step 4:

Using pop dots, attach scallop circle to the front as illustrated. Punch out Word Window, stamp with sentiment. Glue to front of place card.



Step 5:

Cut cardstock for kick stand to measure 1 1/4" x 2 3/4". Score at 1/2". Fold remembering score line is to the outside of the fold. Apply Scor-Tape™ to the 1/4" flap and glue to the back of the card. Position to test placement before gluing to be sure it is aligned correctly.
