

# Pockelope

## **Supplies:**

7" x 7" square of cardstock  
2 3/4" x 2 3/4" square patterned paper, cut diagonally  
2 1/2" x 2 1/2" square patterned paper, cut diagonally  
Giga scalloped punch  
Smaller circle punches or other cutting system  
Crop-a-dile  
Adhesive such as Scor-Tape or Zip Dry  
Brad or eyelet  
pencil



**Step 1:** Score the 7" square in half diagonally by lining up the points on the 6" groove.

**Step 2:** Turn the paper over, align points with 6" groove, score one side at 3 1/2". Fold on the diagonal and fold down corner.

**Step 3:** Turn the piece over. Align points at 5 3/4" score as best you can at 3 1/2" and 8". It is very thick. Fold sides in. Use Scor-Tool to flatten and sharpen creases.



**Step 4:** Adhere larger of the square diagonals to the back and inner flap.

**Step 5:** Adhere smaller of the square diagonals to the side flaps.

**Step 6:** Use the crop-a-dile to make a hole for a brad or eyelet.

**Step 7:** Make an insert.
