



Pick a Petal Pop-Up Stand Alone Card

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Supplies:

Scor-Pal®

Hobby Blade

Cardstock assortment with stamps & inks you choose to use

Scor-Tape

Adhesive

Step 1: Make first series of scoring to a 4-1/4" x 11" piece of cardstock. Score on 1", 5 1/2", and 10" lines.



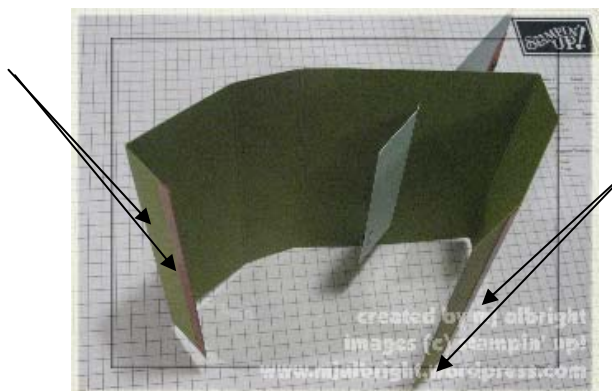
Step 2: Move scored piece of cardstock over to the 1/4" line on your Scor-Pal. Make second series of scoring at 3", 4", 7 1/2", and 8 1/2" lines.

Diana - The photo shows the original Scor-Pal. With the new Scor-pal you also have a groove at 1/2", 1 1/2" and 2 1/2".



Step 3: Cut a slit 5/8" from both sides on the 5-1/2" scored line for your tag (middle line of your cardstock piece). Tag measures 2-1/2" x 5" matted on 2-3/4" x 5-1/4". Embellish your tag.

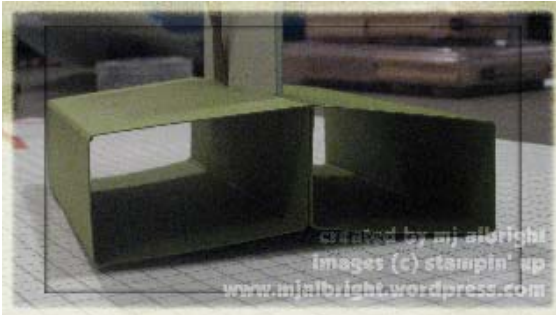
Step 4: You can make cut slit as wide as you'd like to accommodate larger tag embellishments.



Step 5: Apply Scor-Tape to the end 1" sections of your cardbase (the more the better). Cover both long edges on each flap (arrows). Slide tag into the cut slit.



Step 6: Attach one of the 1" sections to the tag (make sure the tag is centered in the cut slit).



Step 7: Attach the other 1" section to the tag...and your card is assembled. The card will slide flat for mailing. Further embellish to your liking.
