
Scor-Pal®
Scor-Tape™
One piece of 4" x 5" cardstock
One piece of 3 15/16" x 4 15/16" cardstock
One piece of 4" x ¼" cardstock (handle)
Cardstock for wheels
Embellishments as desired
Round punches



Step 1: Cut the two pieces of cardstock, pink 4" x 5", white 3 15/16" x 4 15/16"



Step 2: Score both pieces of cardstock at 1" on all sides





Step 3: If you wish to dry emboss the cardstock that will line the inside of the carriage, do it next.



<u>Step 4:</u> Cut in at four places on both pieces of cardstock and adhere Scor-Tape as shown:



Step 5: Fold on score lines and adhere together. Be sure you have your tabs for the lining on the **outside** of the box.



Step 6: Insert lining into box to make sure it fits.





<u>Step7:</u> Cut either a round circle or oval for the carriage hood. I used my largest Nestie oval. Cut 1/3 of it away.



<u>Step 8:</u> Using the larger piece of the oval, punch holes on ends and attach it to the carriage with brads:



Step 9: Insert lining back into carriage box



Step 10: Put adhesive on ends of 4" x 1/4" piece of cardstock and stick in-between lining and box for handle:

Step 11:

Assemble the wheels and adhere to carriage. Finish off with embellishments.

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
